A propos du Moot

擁抱MOOT 捕捉希望—— 四年一輪羅浮會

世界羅浮大會聚集了童軍運動中羅浮階段的年輕人和其他成人領袖。從1931年在瑞士的Kandersteg第一次舉辦時就有二十個國家、近三千名伙伴參與。雖然每年在世界各地都有地區性的羅浮運動，但為了增廣見聞、分享文化內涵、交流世界羅浮童軍的友誼，1993年的世界童軍會議決定每四年辦一次世界羅浮童軍大會。

藉由Moot活動，讓全世界的羅浮童軍彼此了解、包容、合作、成長，就如同貝登堡說：「讓童軍承擔促進和平與善意的責任」，而地球村一系列的活動是想讓伙伴體驗「世界童軍一家」的精神，並促進童軍運動中團結的力量。同時Moot也向全世界宣揚童軍活動的良好形象：一個讓年輕人開放地學習成長、藉以培養國家及國際社會中良好公民的世界性運動。

每屆在不同國家舉辦的世界羅浮大會，讓來自世界各國的伙伴走進不同民族、國家的文化，藉此縮短彼此間的距離，同時開闊見識。我們相信這不僅是文化交流的盛宴，更是世界地球村未來的展望；希望這一次在台灣舉辦的世界羅浮大會也能順利成功，讓羅浮童軍在活動中建立四海之內皆兄弟的情誼，在創始人員登堡爵士種下的童軍運動大樹下牽起手、一同熱情擁抱整個世界。

World Scout Moot gathers scouts aged 18 to 26 of the Scout Movement. The 1st World Scout Moot was held in Kandersteg in Switzerland in 1931. To broaden the vision, share cultures and enhance friendships among all Scouts, the World Scout Committee decided to hold the World

Scout Moot every four years even though there have been national and regional Rover activities taking place every year all over the world.

Just as what Lord Baden-Powell said, all Scouts have the responsibilities to enhance peace and goodwill. In the Moot, Scouts are expected to know

and understand as well as to cooperate and experience the world together. The series of expeditions and global village activities are held to realize the spirit of "we are a family of Scouts" and promote this idea of togetherness. Also, to make it known to the world that Scouting is a worldwide movement for young people who learn, experience and develop themselves in an international environment. World Moot 2004 has the theme "Unlimited Challenges". Indeed, we are faced with tremendous challenges as well as unlimited opportunities to re-think our focus in the context of larger issues of globalization, peace and sustainable development, environment, employment and the hope for more just societies.

Every event of the World Scout Moot held in different countries integrates the idea of friendship of nations, appreciation of diverse cultures and broadening the vision of young people. We do believe that our Moot is not only a festival of cultures, but a heightening of our awareness of the challenges faced by our movement and by ourselves. (Hanna)

In addition, Scouts hiked across the Piramide Del Sol and Piramide De La Luna which are traditional landmarks. All activities were arranged for the Scouts to rediscover the Civilization of the Aztec.
